

## How to describe others and myself to someone else:

<u>To describe Myself</u>	<u>To describe one person</u>	<u>To describe more than one person</u>
Use "Yo" as your subject pronoun (= I)	Use "Él or Ella" as your subject pronoun (=He or she)	Use "Ellos or ellas" as your subject pronoun (= They)
If adjectives end in an "o" and you are a girl then it will switch to an "a".	If adjectives end in an "o" and you are describing girl then it will switch to an "a".	If adjectives end in an "o" and you are describing several girls then it will switch to an "as". Otherwise, it will get an "s" added to the end of the adjective.
Me llamo... (Name).	Se llama... (Name).	Se llaman... (Name).
Es mí. (= It's me)	Es mi (family member). (It's my ...)	Son mis (plural family members). (They are my ...)
Yo soy... (Name or description).	Es... (Name or description).	Son... (description).
Soy de... (location).	Es de... (location).	Son de... (location).
(Yo) Tengo (#) años.	(Él or ella) Tiene (#) años.	(Ellos or ellas) Tienen (#) años.
Mi cumpleaños es el (#) de (month).	Su cumpleaños es el (#) de (month).	Sus cumpleaños son en (month). ***If not the same for two or more people then follow the one-person pattern.
