

Gusta/ Gustan- agrees with how many things you like not who likes it.

A mí **me** gusta/ gustan

A nosotros **nos** gusta/ gustan

A ti **te** gusta/ gustan

A vosotros **os** gusta/ gustan

A usted (Formal you)

A ustedes (you all)

A ella (she)

A ellos (they)

A él (he) **le** gusta/ gustan

A ellas **les** gusta/ gustan
(they- all girls)

***** To express likes or dislikes of actions:**

Gustar is followed by an infinitive and agrees with how many actions are liked.

Me gusta nadar. No me gustan correr ni saltar.

When you have a positive statement and you agree say:

A mi también (me too) for example: Me gusta esquiar. ¿y a ti?

A mi también

When you have a negative statement and you agree say:

A mi tampoco (me neither) for example: No me gusta estudiar. ¿y a ti?

A mi tampoco.

When you have a positive statement and you don't agree, simply state your opinion.

Me gusta leer revistas. ¿y a ti?

No me gusta leer revistas.

When you have a negative statement and you don't agree, simply state your opinion.

No me gusta dibujar. ¿y a ti?

Me gusta dibujar.

When you have a negative statement and you want to state you don't like that either, state "ni" for nor.

No me gusta pintar ni dibujar.
