PARKING REGULATIONS/INFORMATION – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- All students must have a valid driver's license and assigned space to park on campus.
- Parking spaces cost \$50.00 – checks to *Irmo High School*. Application and payment will be received via Debra Carlsen in room 2018 during posted office hours throughout the year.
- Students who withdraw from Irmo HS during the school year *will not* receive a refund.
- Parking tag distribution ***starts at Schedule Pickup*** in August and continues throughout the school year.
- Students may not enter the student parking lot or a car during the school day without administrative permission.
- **Students *will not be allowed* to sell or swap their registered parking space with another student. Both students will be referred to administration.**
- **Students who drive recklessly or receive a total of (3) Category 1 referrals are susceptible to a loss of parking privileges.**
- **Students with more than (5) tardies to their first scheduled class may have their parking pass revoked for the remainder of the semester.**
- **Students who use his/her vehicle to cut class may have his/her parking pass suspended or permanently revoked.**

STUDENT PARKING AGREEMENT according to District Policy (File:JIH-E(2))

I understand the following conditions.

- Students are permitted to park on school premises as a matter of privilege, not of right.
- The school district retains authority to conduct routine searches of the exterior of student vehicles parked on school property at any time.
- The school district retains authority to conduct searches of the interior of student vehicles whenever a school official has reasonable suspicion to believe that a student has violated board policies, school rules or state law.
- If I fail to provide access to the interior of my vehicle upon request by a school official, I will be subject to school disciplinary action, including loss of all parking privileges.
- If I do not display a school district parking permit in full view on each vehicle that I park on school premises, my vehicle ***may be towed at my expense***. The parking permits used in the district hang from the rear view mirror.
- I understand that I am to park only in my assigned area.

I have read this parking agreement and understand that my child is to abide by all the regulations.
