

WHAT WE DO TO ENSURE EVENT SAFETY



School District Five of Lexington & Richland Counties is committed to the safety of its students and school staff at district events.



CLEAR BAG REQUIREMENT

A clear bag requirement has been implemented at all sporting events, beginning this fall. **See back for more details** on approved bags for events.



METAL DETECTORS

The district has implemented metal detectors to screen all spectators, beginning with varsity football games at Chapin, Dutch Fork and Irmo high schools.



ADMISSION

Admission will be charged throughout the duration of games.



STUDENT SUPERVISION

All students 8th grade or younger will now be required to attend games with parents or guardians.



EVENT SAFETY OFFICIALS

We partner with law enforcement and event staff to ensure spectator safety for the duration of the event. School Resource Officers also will travel with teams at away games.

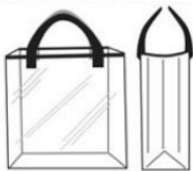

APPROVED CLEAR BAGS

Clear Tote Bag

Plastic, Vinyl or PVC
Do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12"



Plastic Storage Bag

Clear, one (1) gallon,
re-sealable



Small Clutch Purse

Approximately the size of a hand with or without a handle or strap. No larger than 4.5" x 6.5" with or without a hand or strap. Can be carried separately or within an approved plastic bag.



Bags not allowed include: purses, bags or containers larger than a small clutch, backpacks, binoculars cases, briefcases, camera bags, cinch bags, coolers, diaper bags, fanny packs, grocery/trash bags, luggage of any kind, mesh bags, tinted plastic bags
