FACT SHEET



WHY ATHLETIC FEES?

- In developing the FY20-21 Operating Budget, the School District Five of Lexington & Richland County School Board reviewed several options for addressing the reduction of state funding while trying to maintain existing programs and services. One of the decisions made by the Board was to increase athletic fees.
- Athletic fees help offset the cost of equipment, security, supplies, officials, transportation and other athletic costs.

OVERVIEW OF FEES

FEES DETAILS

- Fee Schedule:
 - a. High school students will pay \$65 for each sport in which they participate.
 - b. Middle school students will pay \$65 for each sport in which they participate.
- The participation fee does not guarantee playing time.
- Participation fees are paid after tryouts and placement on a team(s).
- A credit of \$32.50 will appear for certain sports seasons from the 2019-2020 school year. If you have any questions see your school's Athletic Director.

PAYING FEES

- Pay online using a credit card or debit card. A processing fee will be added by the vendor. Payments can be made using the following link:

- Information about online payments will be sent to the parent or guardian of student-athletes via email.
- Refunds will not be given if a student-athlete withdraws from the school, quits or is injured during a contest or practice. Refunds in other circumstances beyond the school and/or district's control will be decided on a case-by-case basis.
- Student-athletes who have not paid the fee or met the waiver by the first game of the regular season can be removed from participating in a sport. Exceptions can be approved by the school's athletic director, school district and/or school principal.
