Hello Harbison West Families,

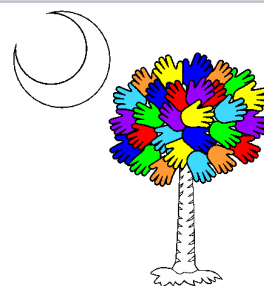

I would love to share a message from our Student Services Officer, Kelly Brown and our Coordinator of Parenting and School Social Work Services, Jennifer Felkel.

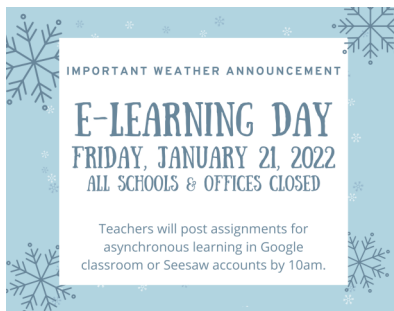

## Symptom Screening Checklist

Students or staff should self-assess prior to reporting to school using the screening checklist below. For younger students, parents should complete the assessment. Have you had close contact (within 6 feet for at least 15 minutes) in the last 10 days with someone diagnosed with COVID-19, or has any health department or health care provider been in contact with you and advised you to quarantine?

**If answering yes, the person should not be at school.** The person can return once they have completed a quarantine period per SCDHEC guidelines after the last time they had close contact with someone with COVID-19.

- **For students, parent/guardian should notify school nurse.**

If answering no, proceed to the questions below.  
Do you have any of these symptoms?

- Fever in the past 24 hours (greater than 100.4°F)
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- New loss of taste or smell
- New or worsening cough

**If answering yes, the person should not be at school.**

- **For students, parent/guardian should notify the school nurse.**

Do you have any of these symptoms?

- Sore throat
- Muscle aches
- Chills
- Headache
- Congestion or runny nose
- Diarrhea
- Nausea or vomiting
- Unexplained fatigue

**If answering yes to one or more of the above symptoms, please contact the school nurse.** Employee & student COVID-19 status will only be shared with school officials/employees/DHEC staff who have a legitimate reason to know this information.

## 2022-2023 4K & KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

### 4K Registration:

Registration for our **2022-2023** 4K program begins on MONDAY, February 7, 2022 and will continue until all screening slots are full. You must be zoned for our school and your child must be 4 years old on or before September 1st of this year. Our registration hours are Monday-Friday from 8AM - 2PM. To complete your 4K registration in person, please bring birth certificate, proof of residence & proof of income during our registration hours.

### Kindergarten Registration:

Kindergarten registration for the **2022-2023** school year begins on MONDAY, February 7, 2022. You must be zoned for our school and your child must be 5 years old on or before September 1st of this year. Please visit the district's website at <https://sites.google.com/lexrich5.org/student-registration/home> to register your kindergartener.

If your child is a 4K student in Mrs. Blankenship's or Mrs. Meg Phillips' this year, you will **NOT** need to register your child for kindergarten. Contact the front office if you have any questions.
