

COVID-19 Close Contact and Quarantine Update:

If your child has been identified as a close contact to someone who tested positive for COVID-19, then your child will be required to quarantine 10 days from the date of exposure. **There are four conditions in which a student does not have to quarantine:**

- ✓ **Guardian provides a positive PCR test within the last 90 days for student and the student has completed the 10 day isolation period.**
- ✓ **Guardian provides record of a positive antigen test within the last 90 days for student and the student has completed the 10 day isolation period. A positive antibody test will not be accepted.**
- ✓ **Guardian provides proof of full COVID-19 vaccination for student.**
- ✓ **Guardian provides proof of a negative test on day 5 or after. A student may then return to school on day 8 of quarantine.**
