

# COVID ISOLATION & QUARANTINE UPDATES

(as of 1/11/2022)

School District Five's goal is to return students isolated and quarantined by COVID-19 to in-person learning as safely and quickly as possible. The isolation and quarantine periods remain ten (10) days after a positive COVID-19 test or close contact exposure. Below are ways isolation/quarantine may be reduced or eliminated:

## POSITIVE ISOLATED STUDENTS & STAFF

May return to school or work on **Day 6** if you:

- have **no symptoms** or are **improving** on Day 5;
- remain **fever-free** for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication; AND,
- **wear a mask** through Day 10.

## QUARANTINED STUDENTS & STAFF

May return to school or work on **Day 6** if you:

- receive a **negative COVID-19 test** on or after Day 4;
- remain **symptom-free** during your quarantine; AND,
- **wear a mask** through Day 10.

## ELIMINATED QUARANTINE

\*Maximally vaccinated means a person who has completed their primary vaccine series and has had a booster shot if eligible.

May return after a close contact exposure if you:

- provide proof that you are **maximally vaccinated\*** OR provide **record of a positive test** in the last **90-days**;
- remain **symptom-free** during your quarantine; AND,
- **wear a mask** Days 1-10.
