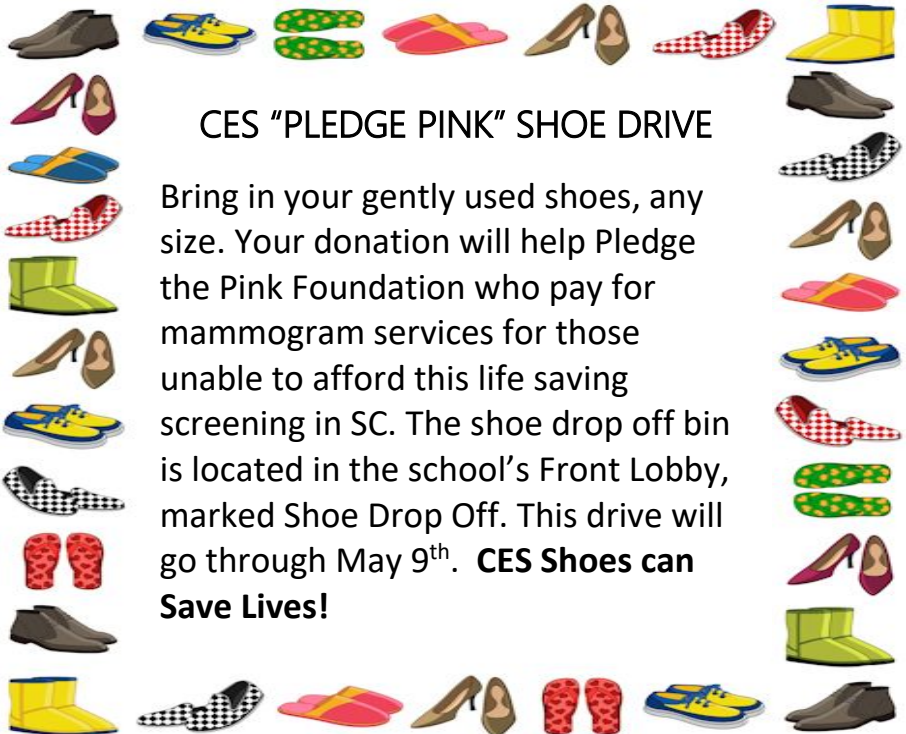

The PTO serves as a link for communication between parents and staff. The election will take place May 8, 2019.

PTO Board meetings are typically held the third Wednesday of each month at 8:00 am.
The following positions will be open for nominations for the 2019-2020 school year:

President: (1 Year Term)

Oversees activities of the entire PTO, chairs the Executive and General Board Meetings. Manage overall objectives and strategies of PTO, act as liaison between parents and principal/staff.

Vice President: (1 Year Term)

Works closely with the President and assumes responsibilities in her absence. The Vice President acts as a faculty liaison with the President as well as reviewing the Bylaws of the Chapin Elementary PTO. The Vice President shall officially be in charge of the program portion of each PTO meeting.

Secretary: (1 Year Term)

Compiles, organizes and shares Executive and General meeting minutes and agendas. Maintain a complete file of all approved minutes, agendas, and materials distributed at any official PTO meeting.

Treasurer: (1 Year Term)

Generate the PTO budget with the President. Prepare the annual tax return. Inform committees of budgeted funds. Pay bills and reimbursements as required. Oversee ongoing PTO finances, ensure adherence to approved PTO budget. Prepare and present budget report for each PTO meeting.
