- In an effort to ensure safety for all students only parents and legal guardians are allowed to visit students at school without written permission from the parent or legal guardian. Parents and legal guardians must complete a Visitor Authorization Form (available in the front office) detailing the individuals who have parental permission to visit a child at Chapin Elementary School.
- A monthly **Birthday** Book Club Celebration will be held one Friday of each month where students will be celebrated and given a mini cupcake. Parents are invited to eat lunch with their child on his or her birthday and again at the Birthday Book Club. Birthday snacks may **NOT** be brought to school for students in grades 1-4.

Food Services

Parents/guardians may apply for free/reduced rates by completing an online [Free/Reduced Lunch Application](#). **Accrued costs will not be removed if a student qualifies for free/reduced.**

During the instructional day (7:00am - 2:45pm), all food that comes from home with the purpose of sharing with and among students **MUST** be store-bought, packaged foods in accordance with School Board Policy ADF School Wellness.
