## Early Release of Students

- Students may NOT be picked up for early release after 2:10pm.
- Students will only be released to those listed on the student information card filled out at the beginning of the year.
- Please allow 15 minutes to pick up your child for early release. If a child is to be released early, the parent will come to the front office and present a photo ID. The office staff will call the teacher and the child will be sent to the front office.
- Parents may send a note to the teacher that morning. This will allow time for the teacher to prepare the child for early dismissal. However, your child will not be sent to the office in advance to wait for your arrival.
