Health Room News: Help prevent the Flu

There are everyday preventive actions you can take to stop the spread of germs. The Center for Disease Control and Prevention recommends the following:

- 1.) Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue if you sneeze or cough and throw tissue away.
- 2.) Wash your hands often with soap and water.
- 3.) **AVOID TOUCHING** your eyes, nose, and mouth. Germs get into your body this way.
- 4.) Try to avoid close contact with sick people.
- 5.) Stay home for at least 24 hours after your fever is gone, except to get medical care, if you are sick with a flu-like illness.
- 6.) Limit contact with others as much as possible when you're sick to avoid spreading the flu.
- 7.) Remember: as soon as the vaccine is available, **EVERYONE SIX MONTHS OF AGE AND OLDER SHOULD GET A YEARLY FLU SHOT. DON'T LET THE FLU GET YOU!** Protect yourself---and others.

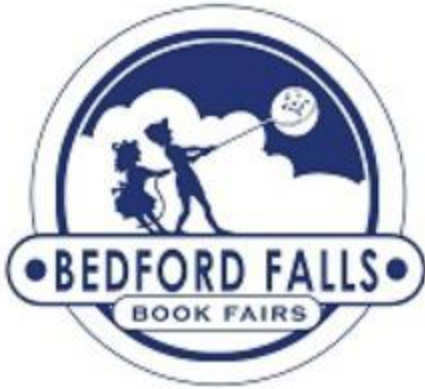
Time: Your Student's Scheduled Lunch Time
