A. MAP Data - Based on Winter Test Assessment

- Grades 2 - 5 (# of students Approaching, Meeting or Exceeding Growth Target)
 - a) Reading - 60%
(1) 9.1% not sufficient data
 - b) Math - 71.6%
(1) 9.7% not sufficient data

- Students who lacked sufficient data were mainly due to not having a fall MAP score, because they were either new to SOESMM or were unable to take the test.
- A variety of strategies are being implemented to help those students who did not meet their growth target - revised grade level/coaches meetings, after school tutoring, increased intervention services
